
School Tours

Topics that were covered in my January surgeries were: Housing - Housing Associations - Immigration . Shingles Vaccine - Small boats Rwanda


I take my surgeries very seriously, and as you can see, they vary on topic. In addition to surgeries, I make regular phone calls.
