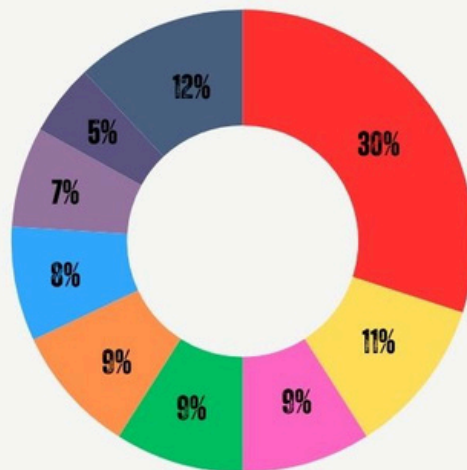

### An update on the work I've done on my 6 priorities this month:

#### 1. Building a New Hillingdon Hospital

IHSS Ltd is a Medical Device Sterilisation Service based in South Ruislip, I saw first-hand their quick and efficient sterilisation process. It's great we can rely on their distribution to the New Hillingdon Hospital.



#### 2. Fighting Against ULEZ Expansion

I met with GPs at Central Uxbridge Surgery who informed me on the impact ULEZ has on patients. I am disappointed in the Labour Mayor's re-election, but despite this, I will continue to oppose the ULEZ expansion.



#### 3. Keeping Uxbridge Police Station Open

As a result of my Crime Survey, residents have shared with me of their request to keep Uxbridge Police Station Open. I took these concerns to Policing and Crime Minister Chris Philp. Read more here.
